1. B. Puricelli called the meeting to order at 4:05 p.m.
2. **Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes**
J. Wicks made a motion to approve the minutes. A. Gill seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0-0.
3. **Crime Report**
M. Green gave an overview of the crime statistics within the Grove CID boundary as of February 2016. He reported that there have been only 76 crimes so far in FY 2015-16. A. Gill wanted to know how the crimes statistics today compared to the previous two years. M. Green reported that through the first eight months of the previous two years, there were the following number of crimes: 103 (FY 2013-14), 139 (FY 2014-15).
4. **TCF Report**
C. Betts reported on crimes that have taken place in FPSE over the past five years. He reported that there were 464 Part 1 crimes in 2011 and 304 Part 1 crimes in 2015. He also reported that 62% of all crimes took place during the warmer months (March-September) and 60% took place between the hours of 4pm and midnight.
5. **SLMPD Report**
E. Slade reported Excise was holding a meeting with all the 3am liquor license holders because there has been an increase in the number of fights/assaults around Attitudes. He said that the meeting was taking place tomorrow. He also reported that there has been an increase in the number of vehicular accidents at Sarah and Chouteau. D. Bellon made a motion to request the reinstallation of the
